



AoFA Qualification Level 2 Award Emergency First Aid at Work for Drivers (CPC)

A one-day course (minimum 7 hours learning) which leads to an AoFAQ certificate that is valid for three years. This course will provide the basic skills and knowledge to undertake emergency first aid at work and is designed for the driving industry. This course meets the Certificate of Professional Competency (CPC) requirements. Learners will be trained to give treatment and to recognize when it is necessary to get expert help.

Course contents:

- **Understanding the role and responsibilities of a First Aider**
- **Assessing an incident**
- **Managing an unconscious casualty**
- **Managing a casualty who is not breathing normally**
- **Assisting a casualty who is choking**
- **Managing a casualty who is bleeding**
- **Managing a casualty who is in shock**
- **Managing a casualty with a minor injury**

The main difference between this qualification and the regulated EFAW qualification is that the managing an incident section has been expanded specifically for road traffic incidents.

Cost:

£80 per learner (minimum charge for 8 learners – maximum 12 learners).

Information:

There are no assessments, unless the learner wishes to extend the course to meet the Health & Safety (First-Aid) Regulations for the first aider in the workplace. This will then entail an end of course assessment and exam. Due to the nature of the course, it is recommended that the learner wears comfortable clothing.

Times:

The course will start at 08.30 and finish at 17.30.
