

Davis Training Defibrillator and Cardio Pulmonary Resuscitation Course

First aiders are often the first to arrive at the scene of an incident and if they were defibrillator trained and equipped, they could make a profound impact on the casualty's chance of surviving. The scientific evidence to support early defibrillation is overwhelming. For every minute that goes by, after the onset of cardiac arrest, the casualty will lose 10% of their survival rates.

This three hour course will provide the basic skills and knowledge to identify a cardiac arrest, to perform cardio pulmonary resuscitation and to operate an Automated External Defibrillator.

Course content:

- Introduction
- Action at an emergency
- Primary survey of a casualty
- Recognition of a heart attack and treatment
- · Casualty not breathing normally and cardio pulmonary resuscitation
- The automated external defibrillator: the benefits, components and use
- Scenario practice
